Charles Lucien Bonaparte, a French naturalist, sailed to the Point Breeze estate in Bordentown in 1823. Once in the U.S., he decided to update Alexander Wilson's *American Ornithology* with a set of supplemental volumes, and his own *American Ornithology* began to appear in 1825. Charles Lucien Bonaparte became known as the Father of Descriptive American Ornithology and one of the first major colleagues in natural history to endorse John James Audubon.
